NLIS Tags & PIC's

I have left this in from the last newsletter due to the fact that when we received our PIC in 2007 we were never told that we had to do this, so I now have 5 years of transfers to catch up on.

So don't delay, follow up and keep your information up to date on the database.

A PIC (Property Identification Code) is required by all owners of livestock to enable them to purchase and sell animals. This also forms the (National Livestock basis for the NLIS Identification System) and serves as a means of giving lifetime traceability to animals. electronic tag needs to be applied to all animals prior to them leaving their property of birth. It is then the responsibility of the new owner to transfer the animal to their own PIC.
